- Have fun and forge strong relationships between the students and their School Resource Officers throughout the week that will carry forth throughout their academic careers and beyond.

Who, When and Where

Our camp is scheduled for rising 6th grade students and will be hosted at Oak Mountain Elementary School June 14th–18th, Montevallo High School June 21st–25th, and Chelsea Middle School July 19th–23rd from 8:00 am to 3:30 pm each day. It will be staffed by School Resource Officers from various schools around Shelby County and Compact 2020. The camp is free of charge, and the only requirement is that the child be dropped off and picked up on time. **Slots for the camp are limited.**

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RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY, AND PARENTAL CONSENT AGREEMENT (“AGREEMENT”)

In consideration of participating in our summer camp, I represent that I understand the nature of the camp and my minor child is qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such activities. I acknowledge that if my minor child believes event conditions are unsafe, my minor child will immediately discontinue participation in the Activity.

I fully understand that camp events involve risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability, paralysis and death, which may be caused by my own actions, or inactions, those of others participating in the event, the conditions in which the event takes place, or the negligence of the "releasees" named below; and that there may be other risks either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I fully accept and assume all such risks and all responsibility for losses, costs, and damages my minor child incur as a result of my minor child's participation in the Activity.

I hereby release, discharge, and covenant not to sue the Montevallo Police Department or the Shelby County Sheriff's Office, Compact 2020, its respective administrators, directors, agents, officers, volunteers, and employees, other participants, any sponsors, and, if applicable, owners and lessors of premises on which the Activity takes place, (each considered one of the "RELEASEES" herein) from all liability, claims, demands, losses, or damages on my account caused or alleged to be caused in whole or in part by the negligence of the "releasees" or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations; and I further agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability, and assumption of risk I, or anyone on my and/or my minor child's behalf, makes a claim against any of the releasees, I will indemnify, save, and hold harmless each of the releasees from any loss, liability, damage, or cost which any may incur as the result of such claim.

I have read this RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT, AND PARENTAL CONSENT AGREEMENT, understand that I have given up substantial rights by signing it, and have signed it freely and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect. In the event of an emergency, I authorize the Montevallo Police Department, the Shelby County Sheriff's Office and its officers, agents, servants and employees to secure from any licensed hospital, physician, and/or medical personnel any treatment deemed necessary for my immediate care, and I agree that I will be responsible for payment of any and all medical services rendered.
